

Summer Reading FAQs

How many books do I need to sign up for? Only one, but we hope you'll read many more over your summer break.

Should I use my personal email account or my mcpsmd.net email account when I register on the summer reading site? Your mcpsmd.net email account is on a closed network so the summer reading website will not be able to send a confirmation email to that account, therefore, we encourage you to use a personal email account.

Is there any written work I need to do for summer reading? In most cases no but some teacher-sponsors might request some form of feedback and it will be up to that teacher-sponsor to communicate that to you and the other group members.

What if I change my mind or start the book but don't like it? You can login to the website and change your selection to any other book group *that isn't yet filled* through July 31.

What is the maximum number of students per book group? The groups are capped at 30 students and it is first come first served so don't delay in registering for a book group!

What if I forget which book group I signed up for? The quickest way to refresh your memory might be to login to the summer reading website which will display the book you registered for. Also, when you registered, the website sent you an email indicating the title you chose and gave you an option to print your selection so maybe you still have the email or the printout.

When and where will I meet with the other members of my book group? Book groups will meet during a regular school day in early September to have their book discussions. The specific date and locations will be announce when school starts in late August.
